The building is located at the Brewery Site which is a unique location in one of the most breathtaking historic areas of the inner city, adjacent to the intimate canal environment of Frederiksholm's Canal and the broad water surface of the Inner Harbour. The site is an L-shape that is separated into two parts by Christians Brygge, a road that is part of the ring around the city centre of Copenhagen. New routes will make a connection between both parts of the site. The building should therefore contain passages under or over the road. Here the main goal is to ensure adequate protection for the users against noise.
