



## Project description

The "Muziekpaleis Utrecht" is a design to extend to the existing symphonic concert hall "Muziekcentrum Vredenburg" four new music halls: a chamber music hall hanging over the symphonic concert hall, a rock concert hall, a concert hall for jazz and a "cross over" auditorium. Every type of music will have its own environment and is seen as a biotope.

The building is meant to act as a music house for large music events in all the biotopes.

Main acoustic challenge is the room acoustic quality of the auditoria, the sound insulation between the concert halls and the noise emission to the environment.
