Project description

The Eindhoven Theatre was built in 1964. The decision to enlarge the theatre with a second theatre was made due to the need for more flexible programming and variation in cultural programming. The new theatre has a capacity of 500 seats. For flexibility no fixed seatings are foreseen. Also the stage area is not fixed. Therefore the hall has no real fly tower.

The design is based on the concept of the Teatro Central in Sevilla.
